Festival of Trees is a display of over 50 uniquely and beautifully decorated trees, celebrating the holiday season.

Hundreds of Stanly County residents view the trees each year. Many schools take field trips to give their children a chance to "ooh and aah" over the vast array of trees.

Businesses, church groups and families also come in groups to enjoy the Festival.

We welcome you if you choose to become a participant this season.

Festival of Trees is also a great way to show community involvement, while supporting Hospice, which has served thousands of families in Stanly and surrounding counties.

Why should we sponsor a tree?

- 1) To help Hospice continue its mission of improving the quality of life for all persons with life-limiting illnesses.
- 2) To be involved in one of the largest Christmas events in Stanly County.
- 3) To show your support of community events, and it is tax deductible.
- 4) Because it's a fun event for the entire family!

What is the cost?

Tree sponsorship is \$300. Then you have the option of decorating your own tree, soliciting your own decorator or having Hospice solicit a decorator.

How long will the trees be displayed?

The trees will be displayed at the Stanly County Commons from Thursday, December 1st, 2011 through Thursday, December 30th, 2011

Why should we consider decorating the tree we sponsor?

Because you have complete control of the theme and look of your tree. If there is a special message you would like to send to the community, then your theme can reflect that message or it can reflect your mission and purpose. The theme does not have to relate to Christmas.

When will the trees be decorated?

You may decorate from 8:00 am-5:00 pm on **November 21, 22, 23rd and Nov. 28, 29, 30th** from 8:00 -3:00 pm at the Stanly County Commons.

Will Hospice keep the decorations?

Only if you request that we keep them. If you choose to donate your decorations then the tree, with the ornaments, will be sold at the end of the Festival. You will help determine how much the tree should be sold for.

What kind of advertising will we receive?

- 1) There will be a nice sign at each tree acknowledging the sponsor and the decorator
- 2) There will be advertising through the newspaper, radio, brochures, newsletters, posters & street sign.

Other events taking place during Festival of Trees.

Angel Tree Lighting - Held the first week of Festival of Trees. Over 1200 angels are purchased by families to honor or to remember a loved one. The angels are then placed on trees for viewing and families are invited to come and take part in a special tree lighting ceremony on December 1st.
